## 1635 GABRIEL HIGLEY

In the name of God amen the twentieth clay of August in the yeere of our lord god one thousand six hundred thirty two and in the yeere of the raigne of our soveraigne Lord Charles by the grace god being of England, Scotland, France, & Ireland defender of the Faith, the eighth. I Gabriell Higley of Shrawley in the County of Worcester, Taylor, being sicke in body but of good & perfect memory praysed be god, doe make this my last testament; declaring herein my last will in manor & forme following (that is to say) First I comend my soule unto almighty god my maker & redeemer hoping of a joyfull resurrection at the latter day. Item I give & bequeath unto Margarett my wiffe all that my moytie or one halfe of the yearly rent of eight shillings wh(ich) is issuing out of on(e) parcell of pasture called berrowe field being in the parish of Astley in the county of Worcester. And also all that my moytie or on(e) haife of the yeerly rent of sixtéen shillings which is issuing out of ori(e) messuage or water Corne Mill situated in the Lordship of the Berrowe in the said parish of Astley called Berrrow Mill & lands thereunto belonging and the appurtenances thereof which said souall rente I purchased of on(e) John Rabolde late of Clent in the County of Stafford gent deceased by his deede indented. To have & to hold unto her my said wiffe during her natural liffe and after her decease I give and bequeath the said souall rent issuing out of the lands aforesaid unto Elinor my daughter together with the said deed indented & the benefitt therein contained to have & to hold her and her heirs for ever. Item I give and bequeath unto Richard Higley my grandchild 12d. and to Ane Higley grandchild 12d. Item all the rest of my goods cattells & chattel whatsoever ungiven I give and bequeath to Elinor my said daughter to have & receive & the same after the decease of Margarett my said wiffe. But..my will is that Margarett my said wiffe shall have those said of my said goods &~ chattells during her life and after her decease to remaine to my said daughter as aforesaid. And I doe hereby make and ordayne Margarett my said wiffe my sole executor of this my last will to see the same executed as aforesaid. I witness whereof the said Gabriell Higley have here unto put my name & seale the day & yeere above written.
