Be it remembered that on the 10th day of October 1849The Rev John Vernon Rector of Shrawley in the County of Worcester Clerk, a copyhold or Customary Tenant of this Manor in his proper person came before Luke Minshull Steward of the said Manor at the dwelling house of James Thrupp called Lenchford Inn at Lenchford in the Parish of Shrawley in the county of Worcester and in consideration of the sum of £500 of lawful British money then paid to EDWARD VERNON of Shrawley aforesaid Esq and of £528 6sh 1d of like lawful British money then paid to GEORGE CROFT VERNON of Bromsgrove in the said County of Worcester Esq such two several sums of £500 and £528 6sh 1d making together the aggregate sum of £1028 6sh 1d being the same sum as is expressed in a certain Indenture bearing date 17th Aug 1849 and make or expressed to be made between the said JOHN VERNON of the first part and the said EDWARD VERNON of the 2nd part GEORGE CROFT VERNON and JOHN BRANSTON FREER Esq of the 3rd part and THOMAS BOWATER VERNON of the 4th part the said JOHN VERNON at the request and by the direction of the said GEORGE CROFT VERNON and JOHN BRANSTON FREER and in pursuance of the covenant in the said Indenture in that behalf contained according to the custom of the said Manor by the Rod by the hands of acceptance of the said LUKE MINSHULL Steward as aforesaid All that his Copyhold or Customary messuage or tenement with the lands ,cottages and appurtenances thereunto belonging situate and being in the Parish of Shrawley and within and parcel of this Manor and called or known by the name of KINGSHILL and now or late in the occupation of **THOMAS FREEMAN**

And all other if any copyhold or customary messuages lands and hereditaments situate within and parcel of this Manor to which the said JOHN VERNON was at a Court held in and for the same Manor on the 29th day of May 1840 admitted Tenant to him and his heirs for ever according to the Custom of the said Manor to the intent That the Lord of the Manor might do therewith his Will.
