

**THOMAS PICKERNELL July 1838**

THOMAS PICKERNELL Last Will and Testament  
Proved 23<sup>rd</sup> July 1838                      Probate Aug 12<sup>th</sup> 1842

He died 5<sup>th</sup> Sept 1832    Will written 7<sup>th</sup> May 1825

I have a Copyhold Estate in Shrawley .... consisting of a new erected messuage, barn, stable and other buildings and about 40 acres of land thereto belonging called (Trickharris ) otherwise Darlings to his son THOMAS to hold to them, their heirs and assigns for ever as tenants in common and not as joint tenants But according to the customs of the manor of Shrawley,

Also my freehold estate called Eastgrove situate in Shrawley consisting of a farm house now converted into two tenements with the barn, Cyder mill, Hopkilns, and other buildings and about thirty six acres of land to the same belonging

Also all my Copyhold Dwelling House, barn , buildings, blacksmiths shop, and about 20 acres thereunto belonging called Smithen situate in Shrawley with the four plots or pieces of land purchased by me upon each of which is built a Tenement or Dwelling House
