In the name of God Amen in the 20th daye of June in the three and forty year of the rayne of our soverainte Lady Elizabeth by the grace of God Queene of England France and Ireland defender of the faythe I Jone Seaverne of Shrawley in the County of Worcester widow beinge of whole and perfecte remembrance laude and prayse be unto allmighty God do make and ordayne this my last will and testament in maner and forme followinge that is to say firste I commend my soule to allmighty god my maker and redeemer trusting to be saved by the death and merites of Jesus Christ and my body to the earth where so ever it shall pease God Item I give and bequeath towards the reparation of the parish church of Shrawley 12d

Item I give and bequeath towards the reliefe of the poore of the parish of Shrawley 3sh 4d to be shared at the discretion of my executores

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Frances her fouer daughters each of them one pottenger

Item I give to her boyes a candellstick

Item I give to my daughter Frances two payer of sheetes one of hempton and one of hurden

Item I give to Frances my daughter another payer of hurden sheetes and three knitinges of hемpe

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Christian elder sone Thomas my beaste **pote (pewter?)**

I give to Richard Cooke my daughter Cristian's younger son a silver spoon and I give to Ane Poke her eldest daughter one flocke bed with one payer of hemton sheetes

Item I geeve to Cristian Cooke my daughter Cristian's yonger daughter my beste **carderne** ?and my beste aprun and a payer of sylver **eyes?** and a payer of hemton sheetes

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Jone one blake cofer with all that is in it and all the reste of my hемpe and flax likewise I give to my daughter Jone my greate **pone?** and six peaces of pewter and one brase potte and two cardernes

Item I give more to my daughter Jone two bowsteres and two pillowes and two blankettes and my prese

Item I geve to John Seaven my sonne two payer of hurden sheetes I give an bequeath to Joyse elseavn a payer of hurden sheetes

Item I geve to my daughter Cristian one platter called the **servanes** plater and my beste **coverlud?**

And I ordayne and appoynte **John Cooke my sonne in law** my whole Executore of this my laste will and Testamente and I geve and apoynte him to have the dealer? yeare of this my lande copyhould And all my goodes unbequeathed I geve to my executors

And I apoynte **Walter Sevearne and John Sevearne** my overseares and I give to each of **them their paynes** (??) and to be taken twelfepence a peace
