Memorandum on the four and twentieth day of October in the eighteenth yeare of the raigne of our soveraigne Lord Charles the second by the grace of God of England Scotland France and Ireland King defender of the faith that ROBERT SEAVERNE late of the parish of Shrawley in the county of Worcester yeoman Being weake of body but of good and perfect memorie did then in the presence of JOHN SEAVERNE the elder THOMAS STONE and MARY STONE declare his last Nuncupative Will and Testament in Mannner and forme following First he did give and bequeath unto THOMAS SEAVERNE his son the whole tack of his teeame and two paires of bedsteads and two table boards which were formerly standards in the house Item all the rest of his goods cattell and chattells he did then give and bequeath unto ISABELL SEAVERNE his wife whom he did then nominate and appointe to be the whole and sole Executrix of this Last Nuncupative Will and Testament

Juxat fuit executrix supra nominat 4th die mernis December 1666 cocam Mr Gul Lygure?
