Late of the Woodhouse but now of Britannia Square to niece Ellen Bearcroft only child of George Croft Vernon left house in Britannia Square and after her decease to her daughter Gertrude E Bearcroft.

Niece Mary Theophania Houseman sole executrix to hold all for 1 year to discharge debts Except £1666 invested in funds where the dividend is to be divided in April and October between 6 nephews and nieces one each to nephew George Vernon Houseman Rector of Quebec, Canada, niece Mary Theophania Houseman, nephew Rev Henry Houseman, and nephew William Shrawley Vernon niece Lucy Agnes Houseman, niece Helen Agnes Houseman.

£2000 now on mortgage on Whitehouse, Feckenham, All shares in Liverpool and London Globe Ins. Co. and shares in London and North Western Railway Co. and all shares in Victoria Bonds to aforesaid nieces Mary Theophania Houseman, Lucy A Houseman and Helen A Houseman
